



Project summary – Energy of nature

Project „Energy of Nature“ will be carried out in Croatia in Karlovac County in the city of Karlovac with partners from Poland, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Spain, Albania and Italy. There will be 42 participants in the exchange, 36 young people (young people with disadvantages included), 6 group leaders and volunteers from the Association for Local Development "Turbine of Changes". As part of the program "Erasmus +" project contributes to achieving the overall objective which is: Inspiring young participants in the project to its innovative activities contribute to protecting the environment through the use of renewable energy and encourage energy efficiency by encouraging the citizens of their countries to participate more actively. The specific objectives are: 1) Encouraging young people for active citizenship and to manage their communities through the international exchange of experience, 2) Raising awareness of young people about the need for renewable energy and energy efficiency in order to improve the quality of life through international exchange and 3) Encouraging young people to establish international cooperation, partnerships and intercultural dialogue through international exchange. Joint activities in the project will last for eight days. The activities envisaged by the project are: preparation and project planning, project management, joint activities: interactive workshops developed and enforced by the participants to the participants, educational workshops on "Youthpass", an educational trip to HE Munjara in Ozalj, educational visit to the "Solar tree" in Karlovac, and creative workshops that encourage intercultural dialogue and promote non-discrimination, and the visibility and evaluation of the project. The methods that will be used during the project are coordination meetings, networking with associations, workshops, educational tours and dissemination of results.
